Example: 'revulsion', 'comprehension' and 'diversion'.

We use the 'sion' after 'ss' and 'mit'. **Example:** 'discussion' and 'permission'.

We use the 'tion' after 'ate' words (location) and after most consonants except for l, n, r. **Example:** 'action', 'deception' and 'reception'.
